

# SHELTERBELT-SHRUBS

Species	Cultivar	Height	Spread	Flower	Fruit	Characteristics
<b>Buffaloberry</b>	Silver	4m (13ft) 10 years	2m (7ft)	Yellow	Red, 3-6mm long (female plants only)	Requires full sunlight Can be used for fruit production Extremely hardy
<b>Cherry</b>	Pin	6m (20ft) 5 years	3m (10ft)	White	Bright red, 5mm diameter	Grows well on a wide range of soils Prefers full sunlight Attracts birds
<b>Crabapple</b>	Siberian	6m (20ft) 5 years	5m (16ft)	White	Red or yellow, 1-2cm	Prefer full sun, will tolerate light shade Attracts birds
<b>Elder</b>	Red	3m (10ft) 5 years	2m (7ft)	White	Bright red, 5mm diameter Large clusters	Shade tolerant, but prefers a sunny exposure Soil stabilization
<b>Hazelnut</b>	Selection from DNA Gardens	2m (7ft)	1.5m (5ft)	Catkins	Yellowish brown to brown nuts	Non suckering Lovely fall color Full sun, part shade
<b>Lilac</b>	Villosa	5m (16ft)	2.5m (8ft)	Mauve fades to light pink as it matures	Tan capsules	Drought resistant Non suckering
<b>Pear</b>	Ussurian	7m (23ft)	4m (13ft)	White	Yellow pear shaped, 3-4cm in diameter Ripens in September	Fall leaves are a yellow-orange Fruit can be used in jams or jelly
<b>Sea Buckthorn</b>	'Indian Summer'	4m (13ft) 10 years	2m (7ft)	Small yellow	Orange, 3-6mm long Female only	Requires full sunlight Extremely Hardy
